During the Covid-19 pandemics, hand-washing is a core preventive measure. However, the use of bar (solid) soap at public handwashing stations faces two major challenges:

- 1. Theft
- 2. Continuous handling with risks of further disease transmission

In response to these challenges, <u>Engineers Without Borders - USA</u>, in partnership with the Response Innovation Lab Uganda, is launching a call for Innovation on the design of a solid soap dispenser for public handwashing stations.
