How to use these resources online

All videos can be shared via their YouTube links. Visit the Repository and click on any video you want to share to snag the link.

How to use these resources offline

- Videos can be **downloaded** to phones and tablets. Follow the instructions below or the visual instructions on the back of this document.
 - o Download the OOGW EMR app from Google Play or the App Store (it's free)
 - o Sign up as a Caregiver and select a language
 - Navigate to the "Learning Video" Section and select the green "Digital Learning Center" box
 - o Register by email or phone for continued access to all videos.
- Ideas for offline viewing
 - Ask that **masks or face coverings** are worn at all times.
 - Wipe down the devices with disinfection between viewings.
 - Provide **community health workers with a tablet**, where the videos are pre-loaded. The device can be shared household to household and wiped down in the transition.
 - The videos can be **projected on a large screen** or backdrop outdoors with COVID-19 distancing restrictions apply. To keep a safe distance, community members can rotate viewing. Or the projection can move to different parts of the community to engage diverse groups of households.
 - **Schools** can show per household by rotating a device amongst the students individually at school for them to view. If available, with headphones as not to disrupt the classroom. A quiz or activity can be held after all students view it to highlight important concepts.
